INTRODUCTION OF THE IOED

The **International Organization for Educational Development “IOED”** <https://www.ioed.in/> is an organization with an international membership, scope, and presence, specialized international/inter-governmental fully Accredited Permanent Diplomatic Mission under a charter and constitutional protocol having Principal Headquarter in the capital city of India, Delhi, established in June, 2014. It is connected with the States and Organizations, having special Extraterritorial Status based upon the International Vienna Convention on the Law of Treaties between States and International Organizations or between International Organizations done at Vienna on 21st March 1986. The IOED has mandate to run innovative educational and socio – economic developmental projects/ training courses globally and ready to participate in the governments’ developmental projects in its capacity as it has strong team of experts and trainers from different backgrounds. The IOED signed Headquarter agreements/MoUs with many Sovereign nations like the Republic of Zambia on April 22, 2016, and Republic of Moldova on January 23, 2019, etc., Joint Commissions consisting six members have been formed between the Republic of Moldova and the IOED, set-up Regional HQ in Moldova to focus on the Projects in better way covering Republic of Moldova, Romania, Ukraine, Belorussia, Bulgaria and Turkey. We are planning to establish Diplomatic Mission offices of the IOED in all Sovereign Nations.

Having special consultative status duly granted by the United Nations in the regular session of 2020, the IOED is also a specialized international / inter-governmental fully accredited permanent delegation to the United Nations Office and other international organizations in Geneva, Vienna and New York. Consultative Status to the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) is the highest status granted by the United Nations, thereby allowing an organization to participate in the work of the United Nations.

The IOED is responsible for dealing with developmental issues, particularly Diplomatic Relations, Educational Development (Research & Training), Cultural Relationship, Economic Cooperation and Security – the main drivers of development to make Skilled, Empowered, Prosperous, Environment-friendly and Crime-free States. Its work can be summed up in three words: **think, debate, and deliver.**

1. Project of Health Sector i.e. the multifunctional manipulator "**Robot Nick Pirogov**".

About the Project: EK300-M coagulator and a line of welding tools for welding small diameter vessels and soft tissues are developed in Ukraine. The project team is ready to transfer the production and assembly of the main parts to Indian tool factories, to provide control over the manufacture and assembly, as well as the training of specialists (surgeons) for work. Control and documentary support

from the Ukrainian side will be provided through the IOED. This will bring revolution in the health sector.

2. Indo-Ukrainian Port side Logistic hub: This project will allow using effectively the potential of Ukraine, which already has a positive experience of cooperation with Indian business, in particular, in the metallurgy. A new Indo-Ukrainian hub located near Odessa, with its intellectual potential, will help expand this cooperation with projects in innovative, scientific and educational fields. The fertile lands of Odessa region are perfect for co-production of food. Implementation of the proposed strategic project will allow supplying of competitive Indian and Indo-Ukrainian products with high added value to the European market.
